Those applying for a place on the basis of faith are required to submit both Supplementary forms A & B and return them to Tyndale Community School.

NOTE: *We understand "those of Christian faith who are who are practising Christians" to mean:*

- The child or at least one parent shows evidence of living out an authentic expression of Christian faith in their life and the community, such as:
 - o Involved regularly in a church activity or group apart from the Sunday worship service
 - o Involved in a Christian group that is active in the community
 - o Serves the church community in some regular way
 - o Serves the local community on behalf of the church

By regular attender we mean:

- The child or at least one parent has attended worship services at least twice a month (or monthly if the church pattern of worship is less frequent than weekly) for a minimum of six months prior to the time of the application.
