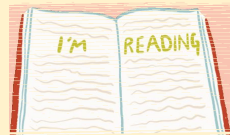
On Thursday, Cocoa and Emma were playing in the field while Sophie sketched pictures of the trees

So is Holi! We're excited to learn more about all these religious times and festivals.

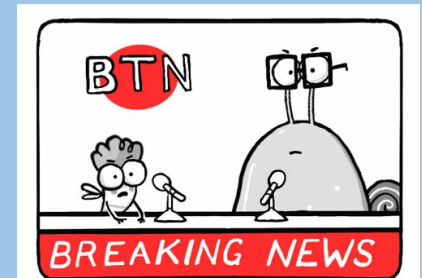

Awesome apple hotcakes

• Makes 10 • Prep 10 minutes • cook 20 minutes

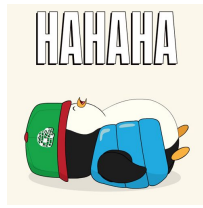
What you need

1/5g/4 oz self-raising ~~flour~~ or flour
1 teaspoon baking ~~powder~~ powder
1 egg, beaten
1/5ml/6 fl oz buttermilk
3-4 tablespoons whole milk
1 tablespoon maple syrup or clear honey, plus extra for drizzling.
1 teaspoon vanilla extract
1 eating apple (skin ~~on~~) coarsely and coarsely grated
1/2 teaspoon ground ~~sa~~ cinnamon
Unsalted butter or Sunflower oil for cooking
Fruit and natural yogurt to serve

What to do

- ① Sift the flour and baking ~~powder~~ powder into a large bowl and mix together.
- ② Whisk together the egg, buttermilk, milk, maple syrup or honey and vanilla in a jug, then gradually whisk it into the flour mixture to make a fairly thick batter. Leave to rest for 20 minutes (or overnight, if easier).
- ③ Stir the grated apple and cinnamon into the batter, adding a splash more ~~with~~ milk if the batter seems too thick. It should be about the thickness of double cream.
- ④ Heat enough butter or oil to lightly grease the base of a large frying pan over a medium ~~to~~ heat. Add 3 or 4 individual ladles of batter (about 3 tablespoons per hotcake) into the pan to cook 3 or 4 hotcakes at a time. Cook the hotcakes for ~~4~~ 4-6 minutes, turning once, until golden and set. Keep ~~warm~~ ^{warm} in a low oven while you make 10 hotcakes in total.
- ⑤ Serve the hotcakes topped with fruit and yogurt, then drizzle with a little extra ~~maple~~ ~~syrup~~ maple syrup or honey.
